Notes on Licensing Options

TET Features

PDFlib TET (Text Extraction Toolkit) allows you to extract the text contents from PDF documents. It offers the following features:

- ▶ TET supports all kinds of PDF documents, including encrypted PDF.
- ▶ All font and encoding flavors are correctly handled, including CJK (Chinese, Japanese, Korean) text in horizontal and vertical writing modes.
- ▶ Unicode mapping: the text on a page will be normalized to Unicode, regardless of the original font and encoding.
- ▶ Ligatures and other sequences will be decomposed.
- ▶ Geometry: precise position, glyph width, and font information is available for the text on a page.
- ▶ Content analysis: Advanced content processing algorithms enhance the results of the low-level text extraction by determining word breaks, removing redundant text (e.g. shadow effects), and rearranging the text into proper reading order.
- ▶ pCOS: The PDFlib Comprehensive Object Syntax interface offers an easy string syntax for obtaining arbitrary objects from a PDF, such as document info fields, XMP metadata, list of fonts, etc.
- ▶ Using the TET command-line tool the information retrieved from a PDF document can be presented in XML format for processing with other tools.

TET is suitable for server use (thread-safe and robust, no memory leaks, clean exception handling), and includes many workarounds for malformed PDF documents. A variety of options is supported which can be used to control the text extraction process in detail.

A detailed description of TET features can be found in the documentation.

Scope of a License

One license covers a single computer running under the selected operating system platform, regardless of the number of CPUs. Development licenses for machines which are not used for production purposes and run under the same operating system are free with each purchase. Redundant (backup) machines do not require a separate license, provided they are never used concurrently with the actual production machines. Groups of load-balancing servers require a license for every server in the group.

Operating System Platform

Supplying the name of the target operating system platform is a strict requirement since the license is bound to a specific platform. The license is valid for all supported language bindings (programming languages) on the selected platform.

A separate price list is available for IBM eServer iSeries and zSeries. Note that we can deliver our products for even more platforms than those listed on this form; please contact us for details.

Support
